

WHY FUTURE CITIES? THE BENGALURU STORY

Bengaluru, the capital city of Karnataka and a major IT hub in India has emerged as one of the fastest-growing cities in the country. Popularly known as the 'Silicon Valley' of India, Bengaluru is the fourth-highest GDP contributor. 
